

CAR PARKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read and understand these terms and conditions before you use a car park

Car Parking at Inverness Airport

Welcome to Inverness Airport (Airport) and to the car parking facilities that the Highlands and Islands Airports Limited provide for the use of our passengers, family and friends.

You are welcome to use the car parking facilities at the Airport provided that you comply with the conditions of use set out here. If you do not comply with the conditions of use we may prevent you from using the car parking facilities. We will prevent anyone from using the car parking facilities at the Airport if they cause damage to property, behave in an anti-social manner or are not using the car parking facilities at the Airport in connection with travelling to or from the Airport by air.

Entry to and Exit from the Car Park

You must purchase a ticket before you enter the car park. You may park your vehicle in the car park when you have purchased a ticket. The cost of parking your vehicle in the car park is displayed at the entrance to the car parks and in the terminal building.

Please keep your parking ticket with you at all times; you may need to show your ticket to a member of our staff and will need to produce your ticket to leave the car park. We may prevent you from removing your vehicle from the car park until you have paid to us the cost of parking your vehicle in the car park.

In exceptional circumstances, we may refund to you the cost of parking your vehicle in the car park. If we refund to you the cost of parking your vehicle in the car park we will make a charge to you of £10.

Safety

Car parks are may be dangerous. Please take care at all times. Take particular care of children. You must prevent children in your care from playing in the car parks. Please drive carefully and slowly in the car parks and obey the traffic signs.

When you have parked your vehicle in the car park, please leave the car park through the nearest exit.

If you are involved in an accident in the car park, please report the matter to a member of our staff immediately.

Security

Please make sure that your vehicle is locked and the windows are closed before you leave the car park. Please activate any security device that you use to prevent the theft of or from your vehicle. Please take your all your possessions with You. If you are unable to take all of your possessions with you, place any remaining possessions out of sight. We recommend that you take out a policy of insurance from using the car parking facilities at the Airport against theft of your possessions from your vehicle.

If a theft of or from your vehicle occurs, please inform the police immediately, then immediately inform a member of our staff and your insurer.

Long Stay and Abandoned Vehicles

Please inform us in writing if you intend to leave your vehicle in a car park for more than 28 days.

We may sell any vehicle in the car park which we reasonably believe has been abandoned. We will regard as abandoned any vehicle whose owner is not in possession of a valid season ticket and which has been left in the car park for more than 28 days without us being informed.

We will make reasonable enquiries to identify the registered keeper of any vehicle in the car park that we reasonably believe has been abandoned. We will write to the registered keeper of any vehicle which we reasonably believe had been abandoned in the car park and inform them that We intend to sell the vehicle within 28 days of writing to them.

We will use the proceeds of the sale of the abandoned vehicle to pay the cost of parking the vehicle in the car park, the cost of keeping the vehicle before the sale and the cost of the sale of the vehicle. We will keep the remaining proceeds of the sale of the abandoned vehicle for three months. We will pay the remaining proceeds of sale to the registered keeper of the abandoned vehicle at any time within three months of the sale of the abandoned vehicle, provided that the registered keeper of the abandoned vehicle provides to us proof that they are the registered keeper of the abandoned vehicle
